

## **Best Practices**

### **1. Title: Inculcating cultural, ethical and spiritual values in students**

#### **Objectives of the Practice:**

A holistic education must aim at inculcation of ethical values in students besides imparting formal education. In order to provide value based education to masses Shromani Gurudwara Prabhandak Committee (S.G.P.C.) has established a large number of institutions. Our college is also being run under the management of S.G.P.C. and has following objectives:

- ❖ Emphasis on inculcation of ethical and spiritual values in its students
- ❖ To make students aware of their moral responsibilities
- ❖ To foster the ideals of simplicity, service and prayer that remains at the root of all our developmental activities.

#### **The Context:**

The need to incorporate value education has been the intrinsic part of higher education policies since independence. In consonance with this, a number of activities are organized within the college campus. The institution has in practice a code of ethics and conduct for its teachers and support staff and for students too. In addition to this, students participate in awareness rallies and marches, poster making, slogan writing contests against evils and menaces. To relate them to their cultural roots, festivals like Lohri, Basant, Holi, Baisakhi, Teej and Diwali are celebrated with lead participation of students. There is a Gurudwara building within the campus where recitation of the Holy Gurbani takes place every day. Spiritual values are instilled in students through celebration of Gurburabs. The College offers its students participation in sports that results in promotion of senses of unity, obedience, cooperation and leadership in students.

#### **The Practice:**

- ❖ Invocation to the Almighty is done at the beginning of session in the month of July when the Path of Sri Sukhmani Sahib is held and in the beginning of each month on the day of Sangrand (Sankranti)
- ❖ Teej Festival is celebrated in the month of August
- ❖ Visit to School for Exceptional Children is organized every year by the Department of Education for students of B.A.B.Ed. & B.Sc.B.Ed. Semester-II as part of their curriculum to sensitize them about the needs of special children and make them aware about their moral responsibility. Students and teachers also pay donation to this school in form of some cash, eatables etc.
- ❖ Khalsayi Khed Utsav is organized in month of October by our management S.G.P.C every year for students to develop the sense of unity, cooperation, and leadership among them.

- ❖ In the month of February Gurburab is celebrated. This is done with active participation of students in form of recitation of Gurbani (Sehaj Path), performing Kirtan, Ardas, preparation and serving of Langar.
- ❖ Science and Business Fair are organized to develop a sense of cooperation and competition among students through team work.

### **Evidence of Success**

- ❖ An assembly of students has been organized every month on Sangrand and other special occasions in the morning to inculcate the moral and ethical values.
- ❖ The Gurburab was celebrated on 30 January, 2021 with active participation of college staff and students. The various duties like decoration of Gurudwara Sahib, preparation of langar, serving of langar and washing of dishes etc. were assigned to different departments. All the duties were carried out by the students and teachers collectively which fills the sense of sewa (service) in them.
- ❖ Business Fair named Entrepreneurial Carnival was organized on January 21, 2021 in which all the students of commerce department participated and exhibited a great team work.
- ❖ Workshop on Application of Mathematics: An Interdisciplinary Approach was organized on 8 February, 2021.
- ❖ Lohri and Basant Utsav were celebrated in the college.
- ❖ This year was dedicated to 400<sup>th</sup> Prakash Purav of Shri Guru Teg Bahadur Ji and many events like webinar, quiz, essay writing etc. were organized in the college.
- ❖ Babbar Day which falls on 27/02/2021 was celebrated on 22 February 2021 by the department of social sciences.
- ❖ Many National and International days dedicated to environment were celebrated in the college.

### **Problems Encountered and Resources Required**

- ❖ Due to Covid-19 Teej Festival and Khalsayi Khed Utsav could not be celebrated as educational institutions remained shut.
- ❖ The visit to Exceptional School was not organized due to lack of transport facility and the Covid-19 pandemic.

## **2. Title: Providing Financial Assistance to the students**

### **Objectives of the Practice:**

The founders of this college have the vision of imparting higher education to the people of the backward (kandi) area. From last 52 years, the college has been striving hard to follow this vision. All the scholarship schemes of Centre and Punjab government are implemented in the college but still there remains some weaker section of the society that does not fall

under any reservation category. Therefore to help the students of those weaker sections, the college provides financial assistance to them through various means. The objective of this is to make education within the reach of people of nearby backward areas which would ultimately leads to upliftment of the society.

**The Context:**

The college management committee, S.G.P.C. Sri Amritsar Sahib has long history of serving the community and for this purpose the committee has established various educational institutions in Punjab and its adjoining places. Besides imparting education, the committee has been providing financial assistance to the Amritdhari (Baptized) students irrespective of caste, gender, colour and creed. Within the campus, the III Science Society was established in year 2017 for the holistic development of the students and for providing financial aid to the bright students of weaker section. The college also prepares budget for providing financial assistance to the needy students

**The Practice:**

- ❖ The S.G.P.C provides Rs. 4000 and Rs. 8000 to the Amritdhari students of undergraduate and postgraduate courses respectively.
- ❖ The III Science Society generates funds by collecting membership fee from science students and science faculty members. The membership fee for students is Rs. 100, for adhoc faculty members is Rs. 500 and for permanent faculty members is Rs. 1000. Minimum 10% of the total fund collected during the whole academic session is utilized for providing scholarships to meritorious and needy students.
- ❖ During the session 2020-21, applications were invited from meritorious and needy students for financial aid. A committee was constituted for allocating fund of Rs 50,000 among the deserving students after scrutinizing the applications received. The committee consisted of convener of scholarship cell and all the HoDs of various departments.

**Evidence of Success:**

During the session 2020-21, total thirty-three (33) needy and deserving students have received financial aid of one lakh thirty three thousands (1, 32000/-) which helped them in continuing their education.
