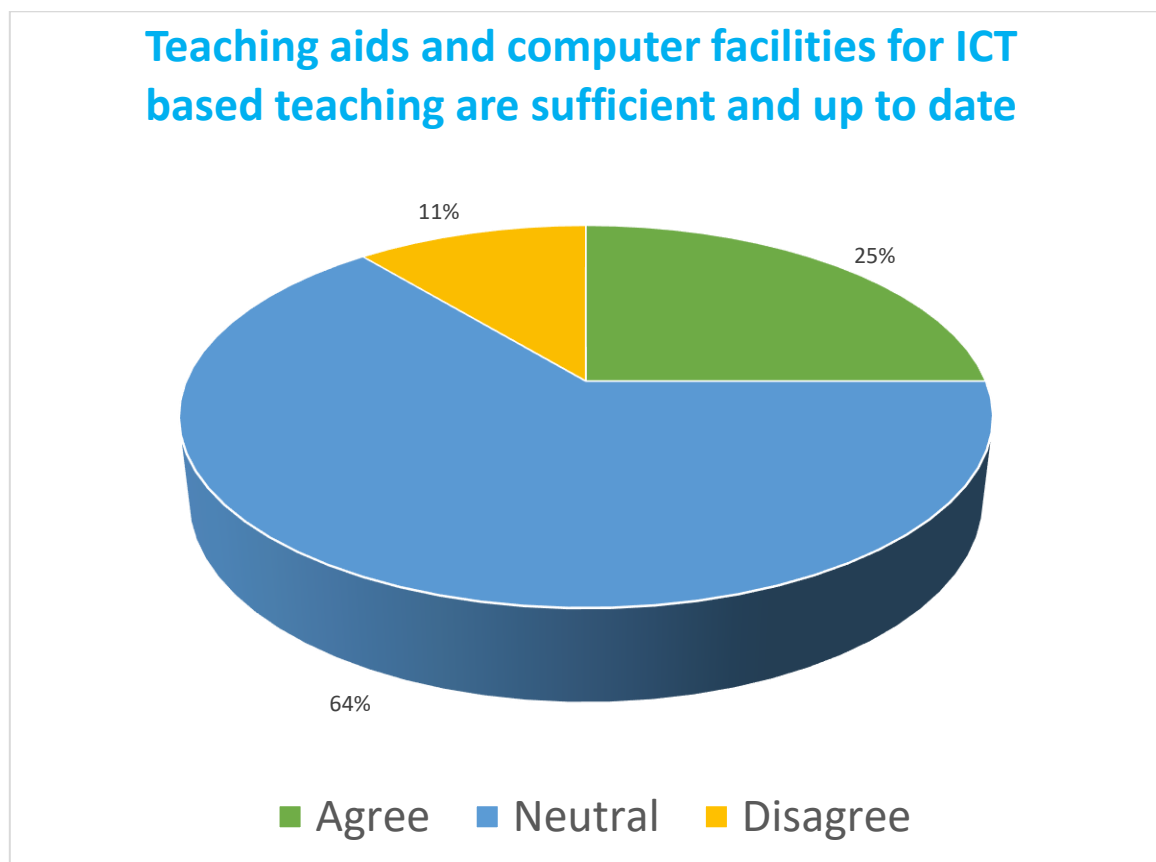

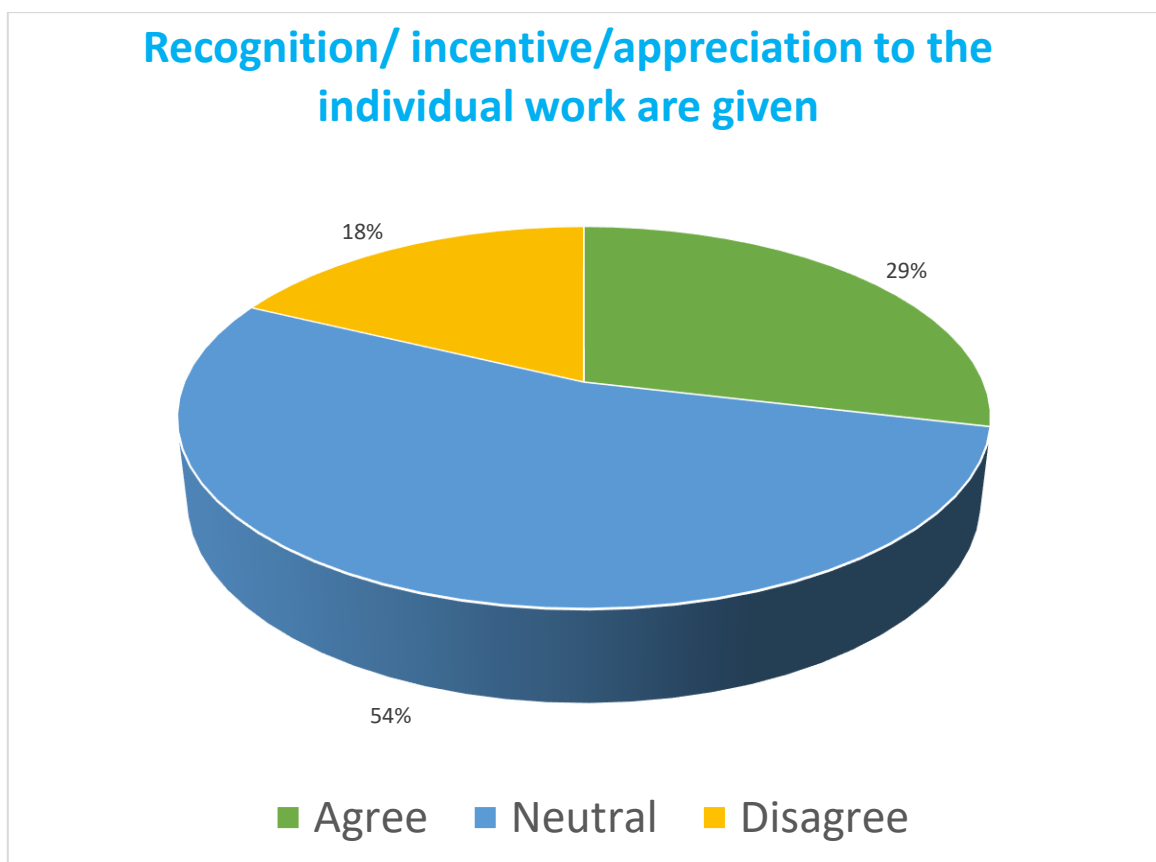

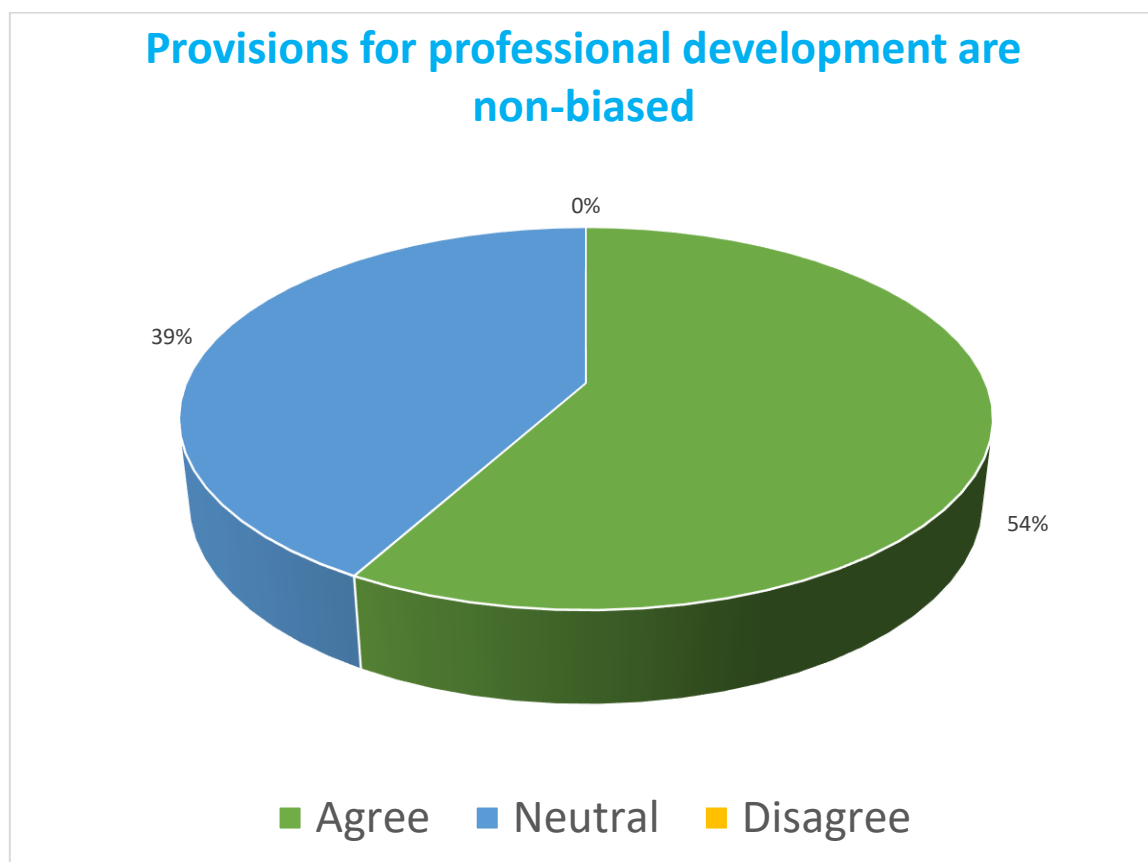

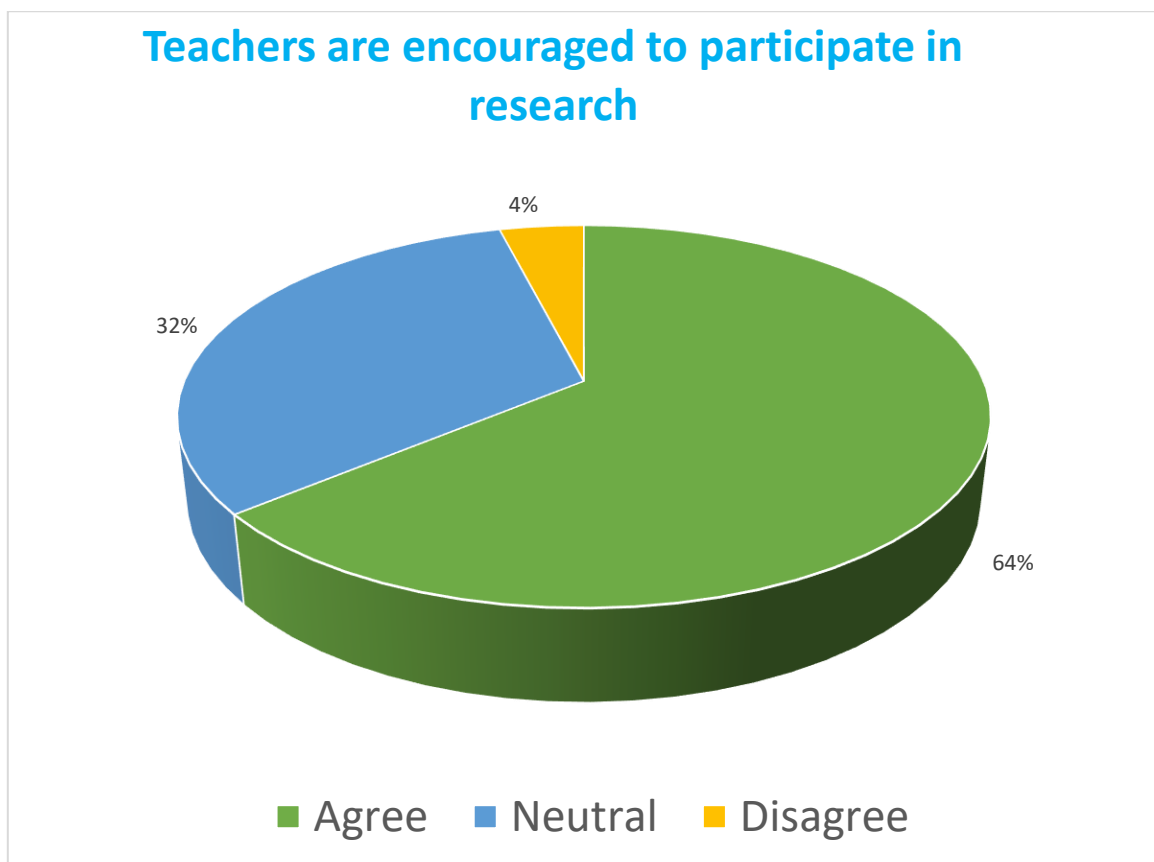

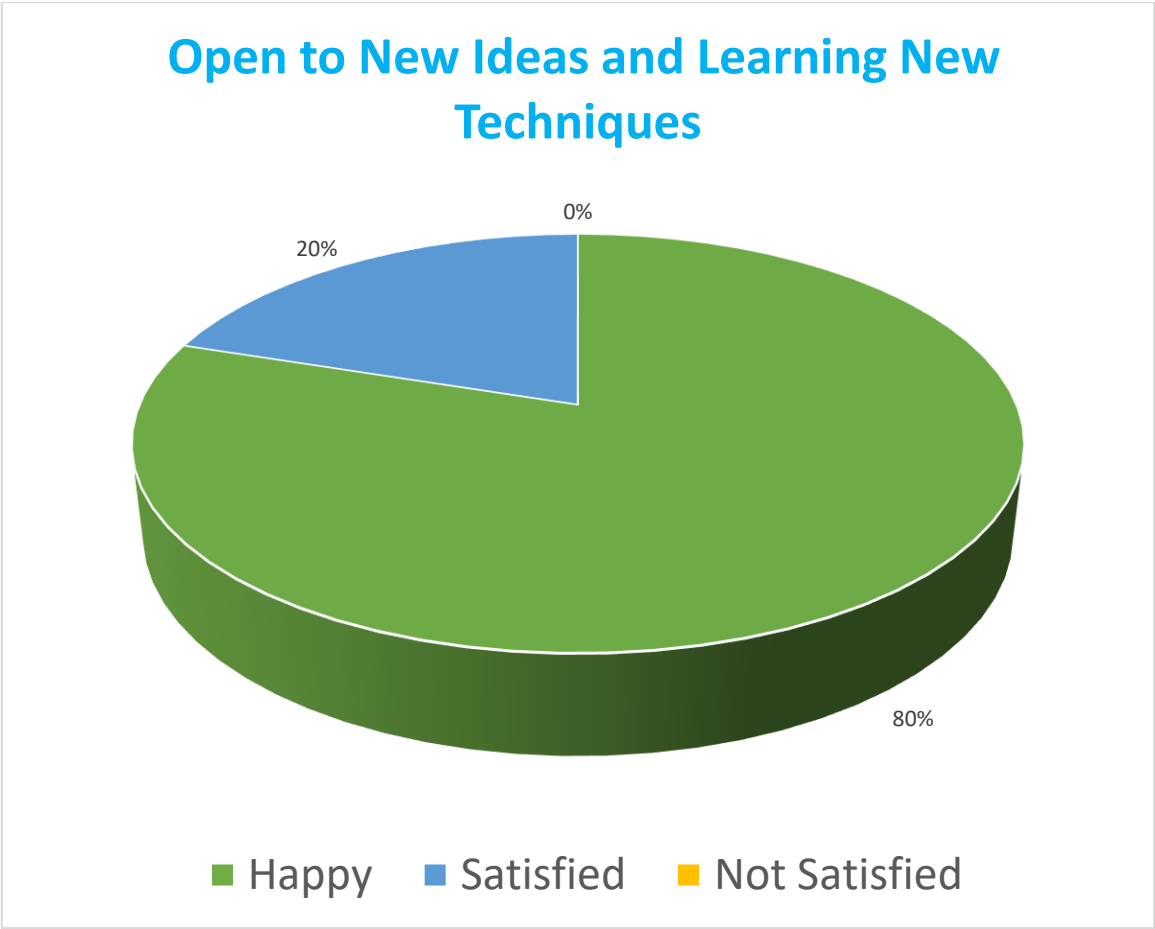

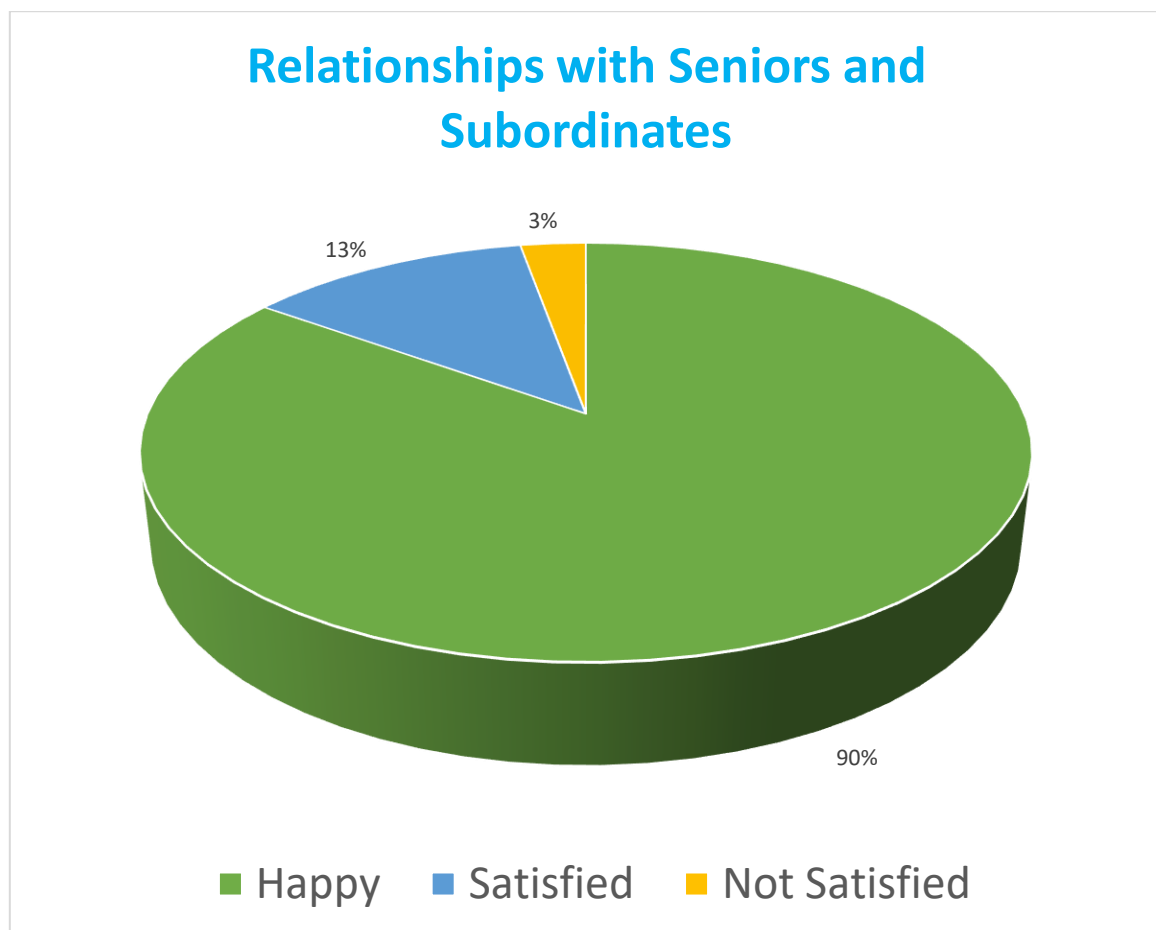

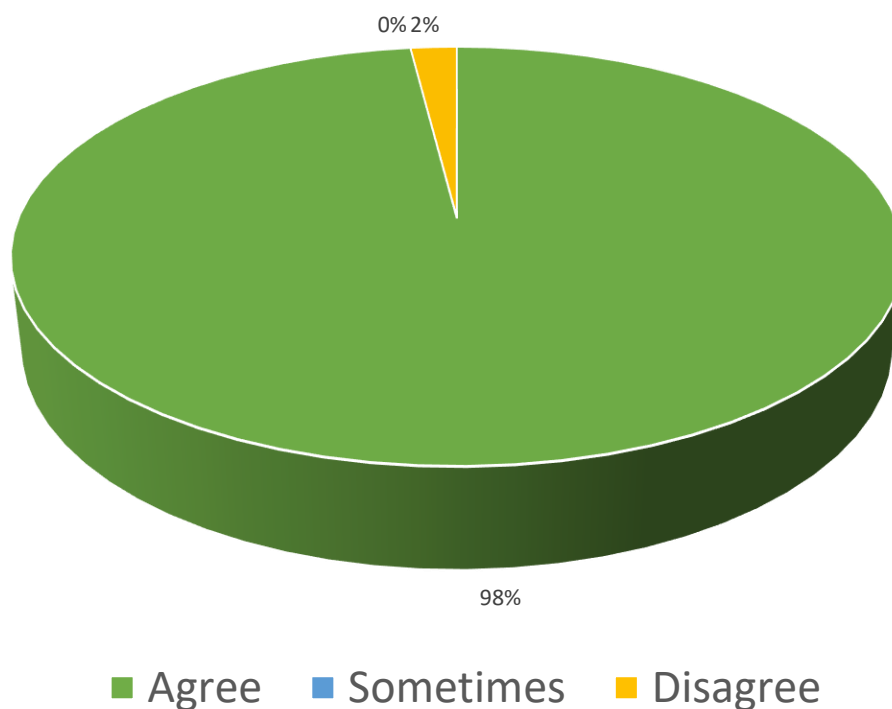

Do you feel proud to be associated with BAMKC as an Alumni?

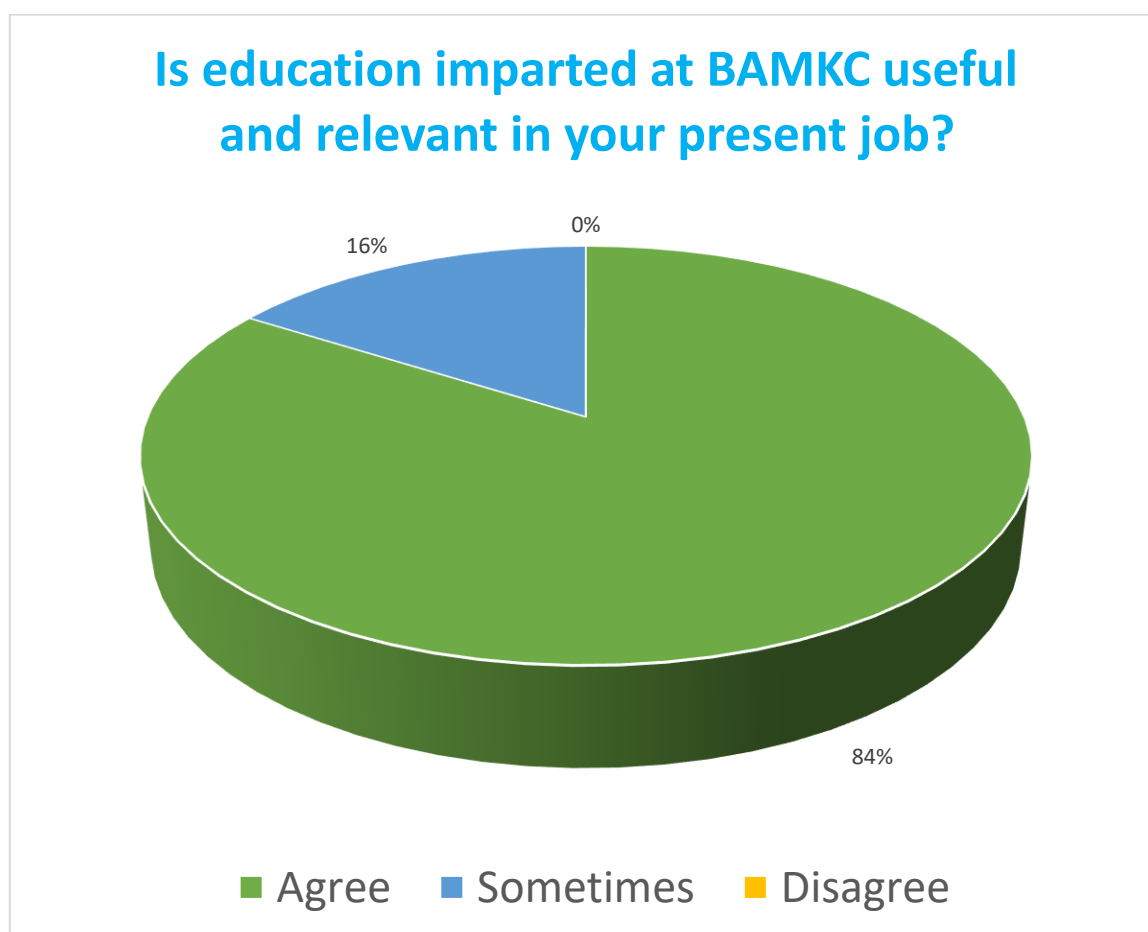

Is education imparted at BAMKC useful and relevant in your present job?

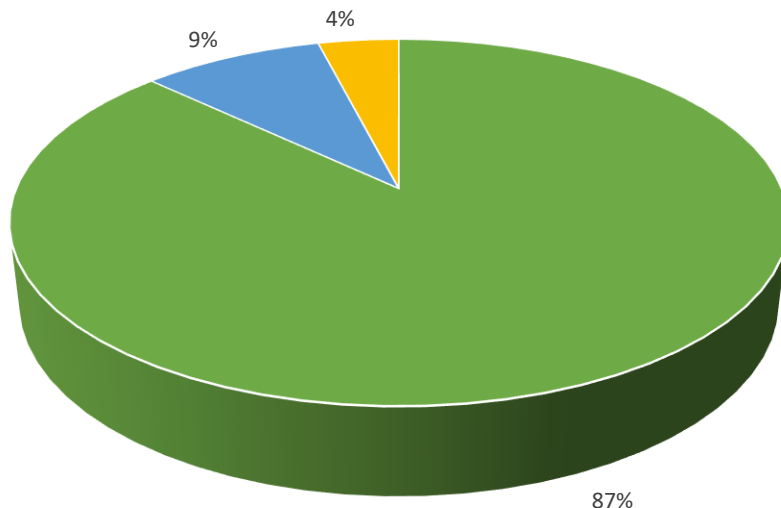

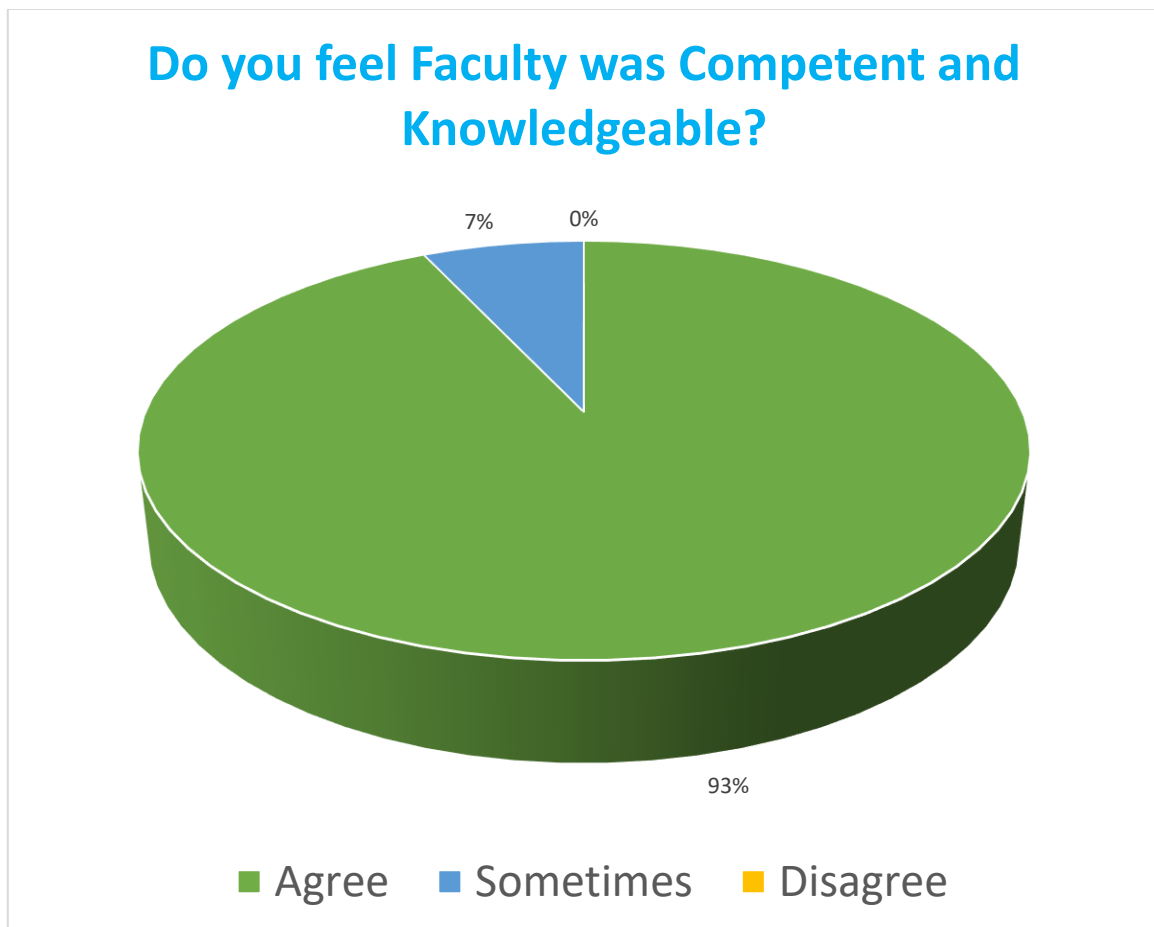

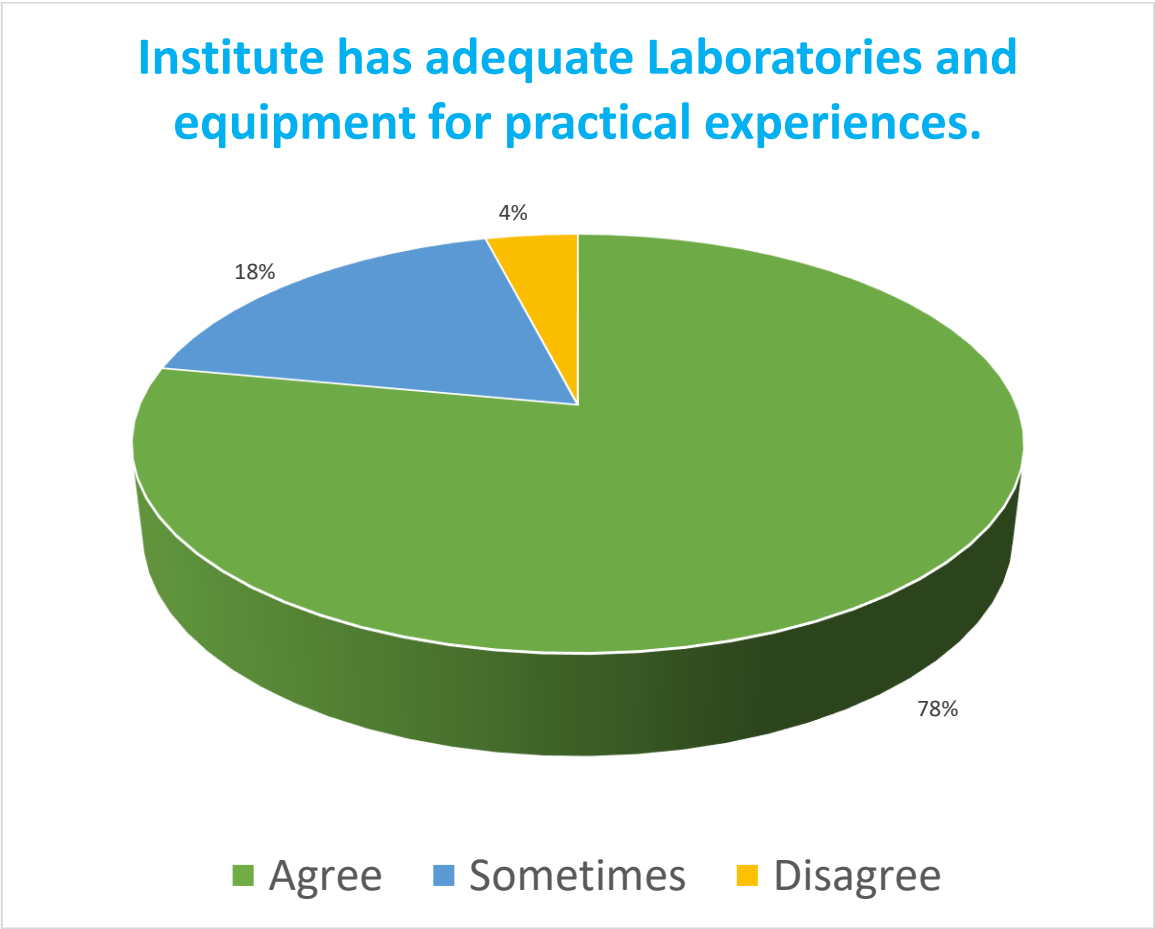
Do you feel Faculty was Competent and Knowledgeable?

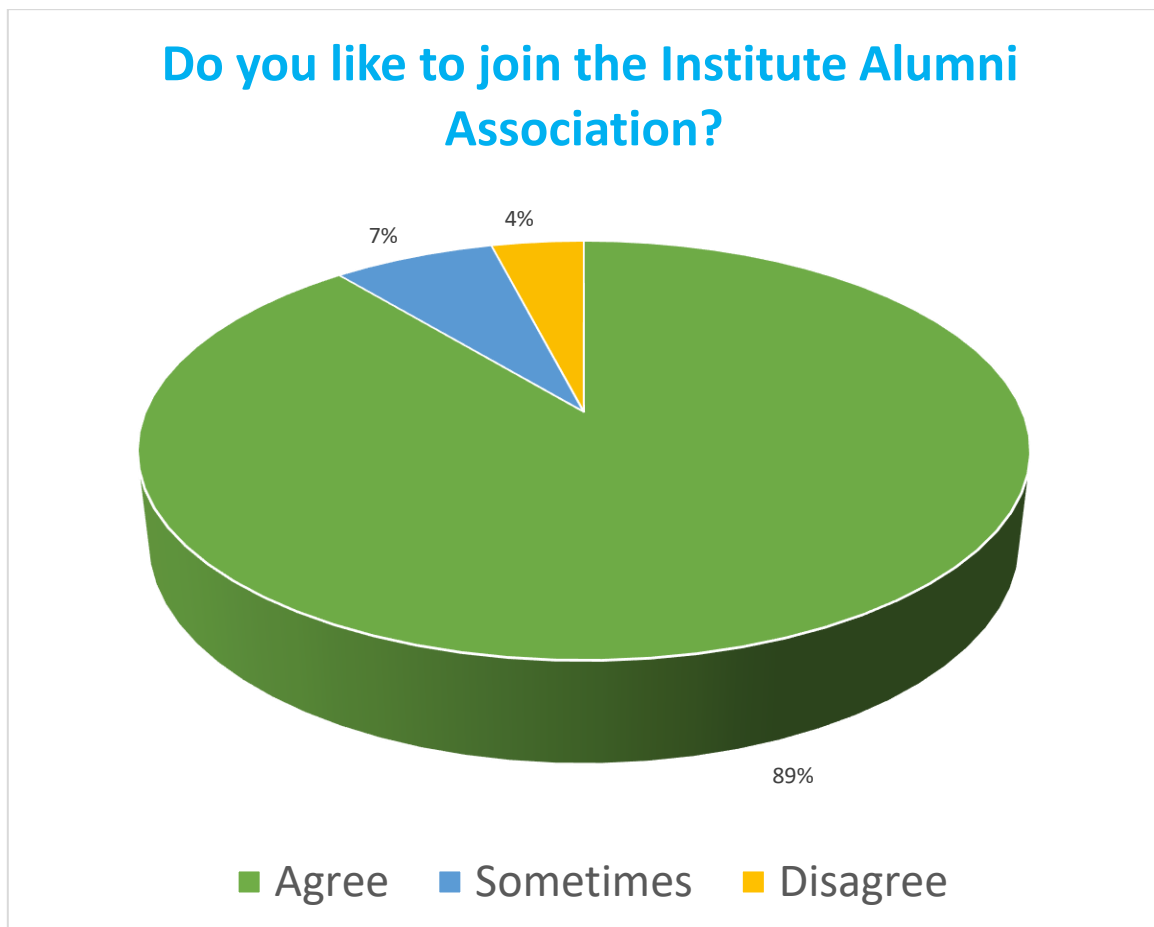

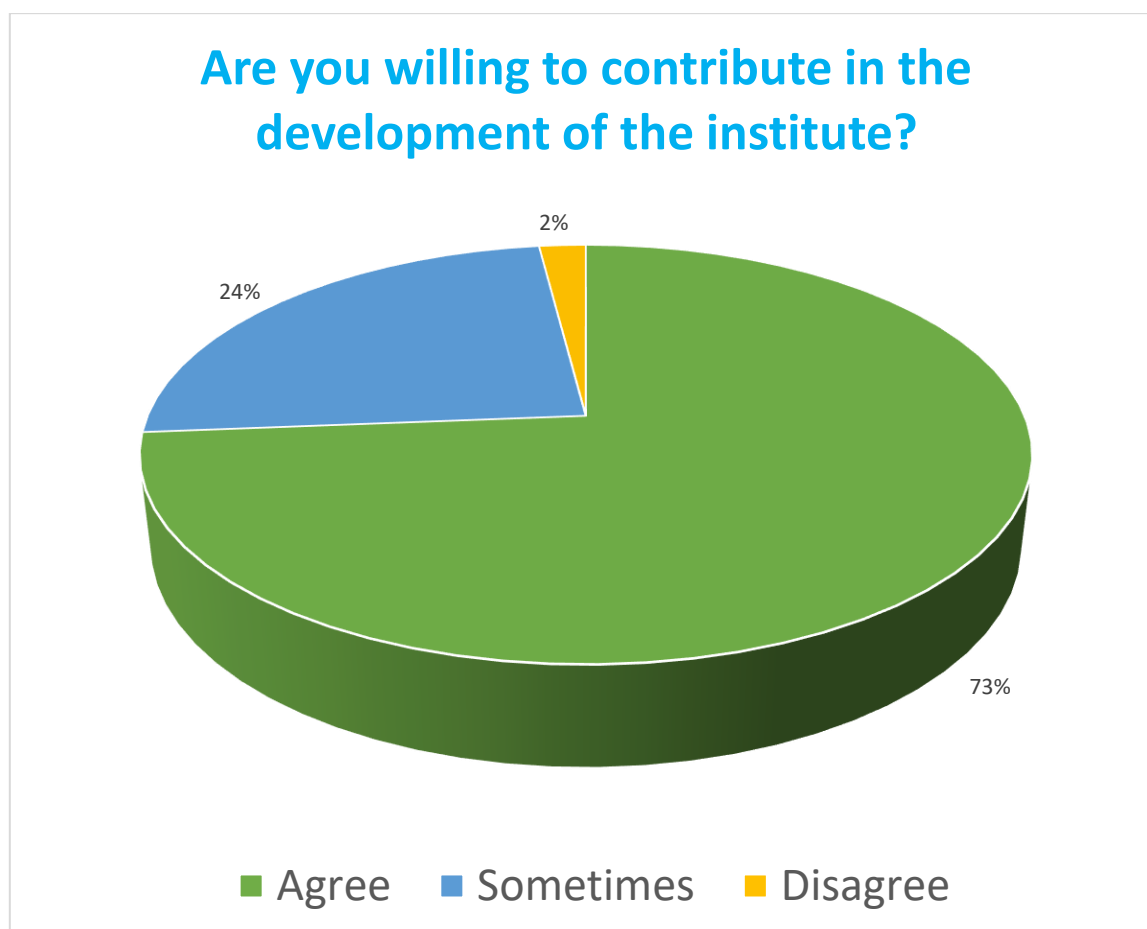
Do you like to join the Institute Alumni Association?

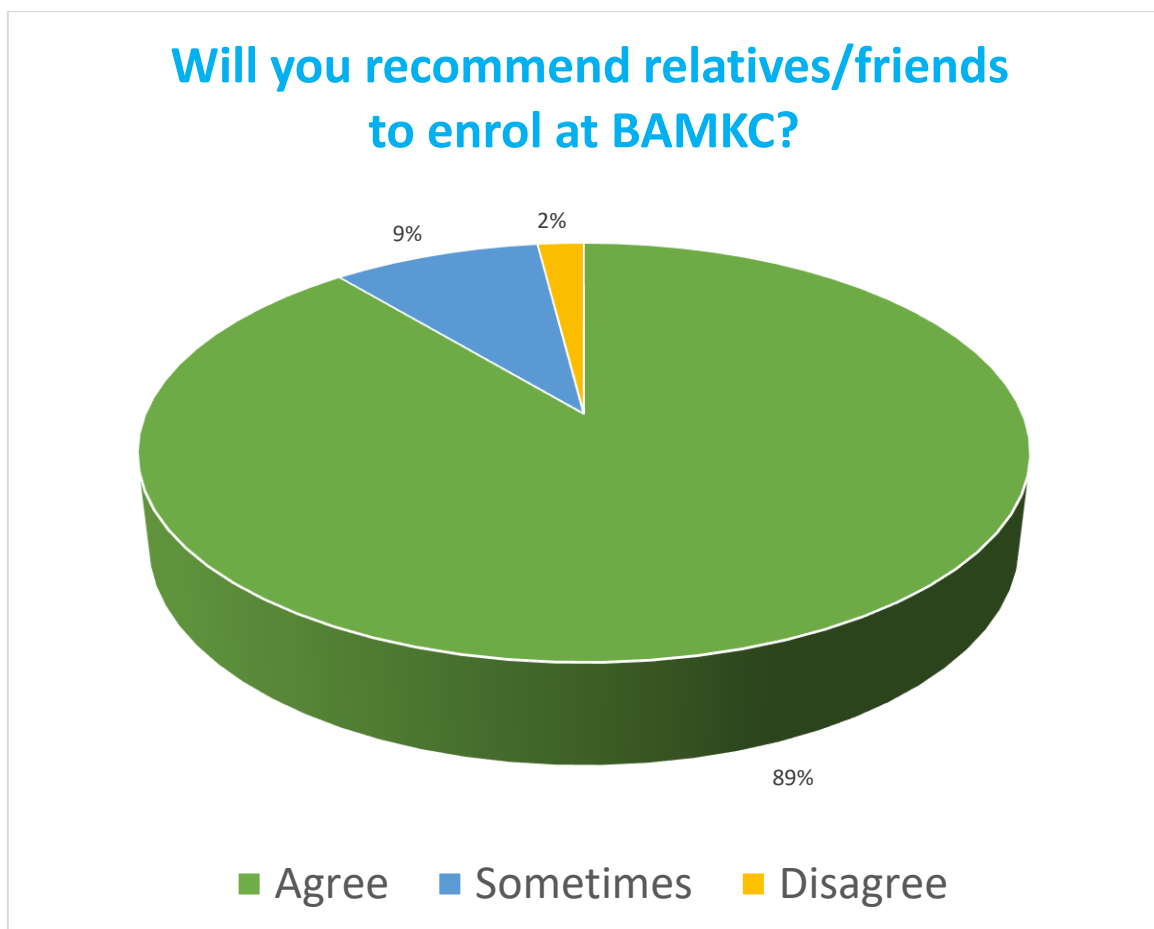

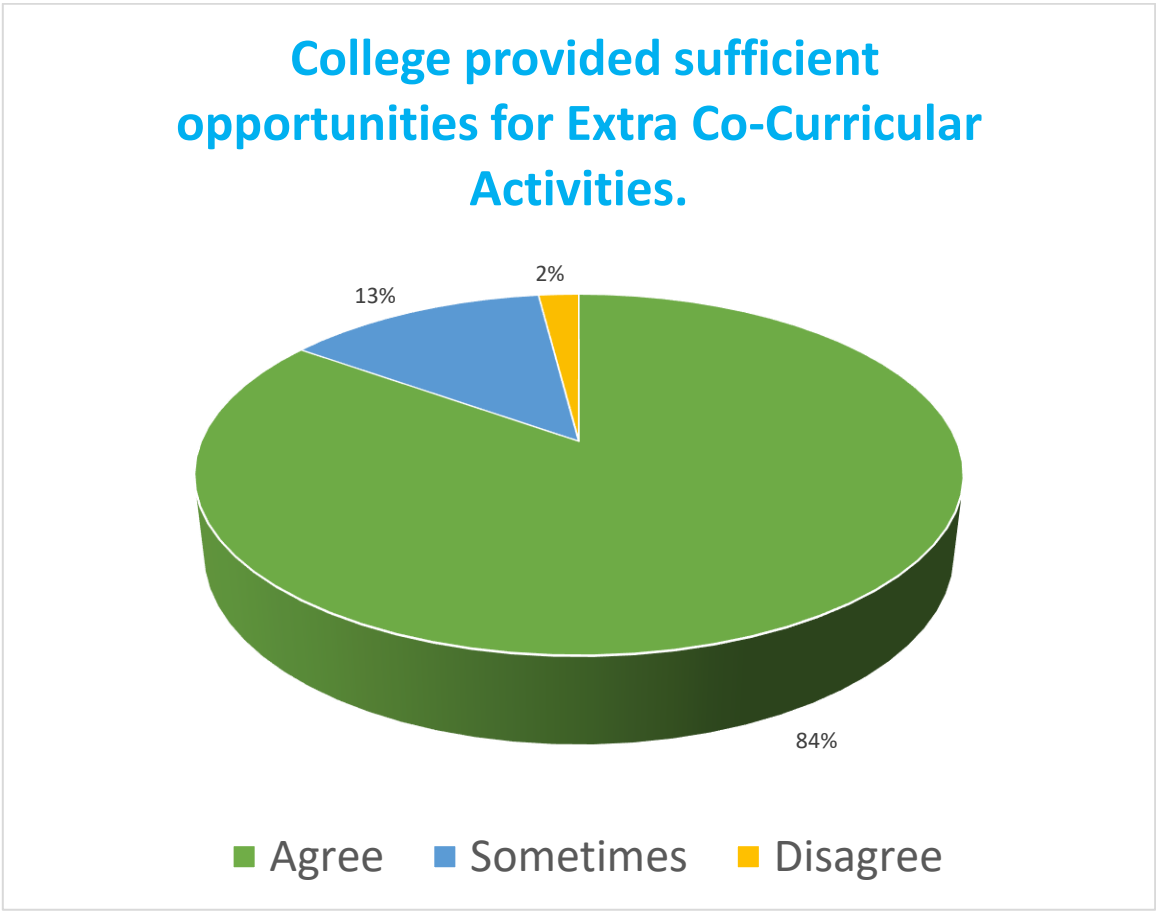

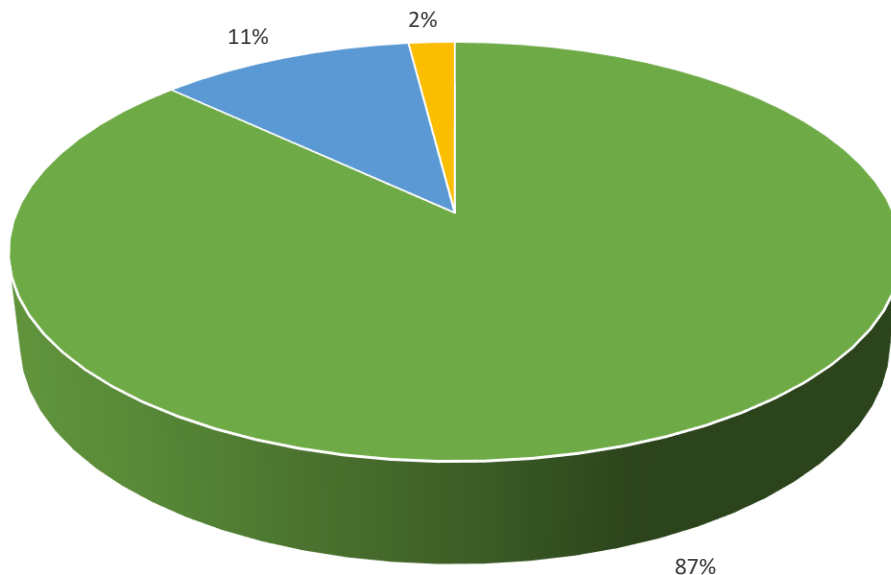

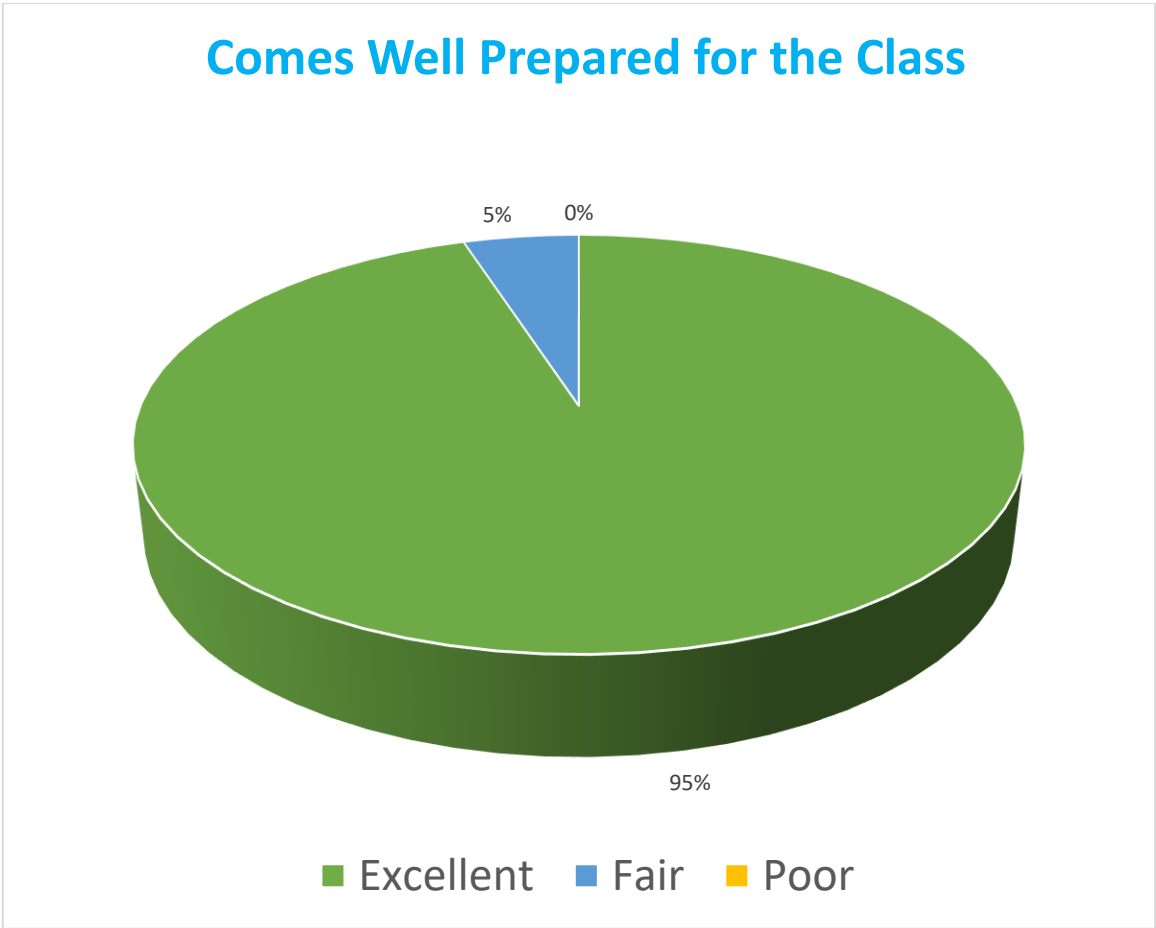

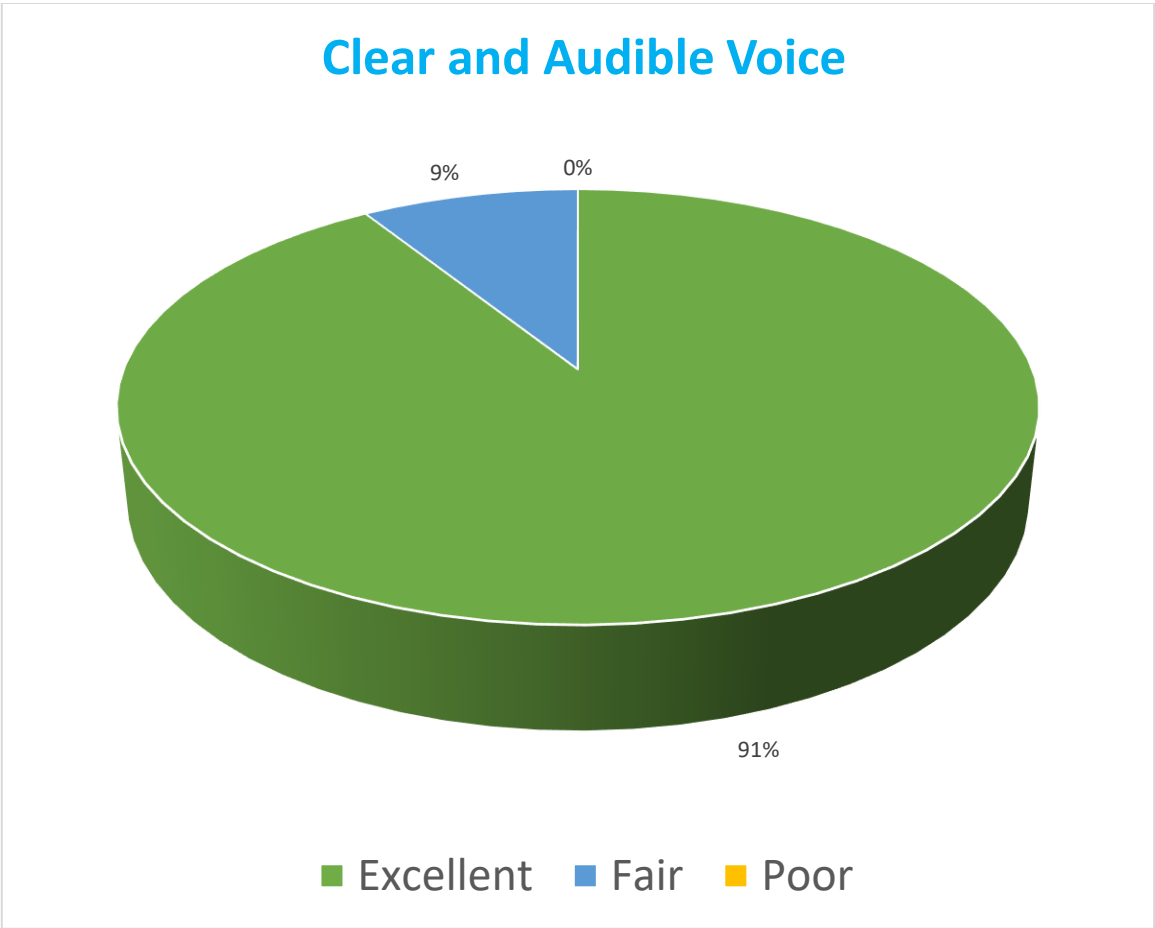

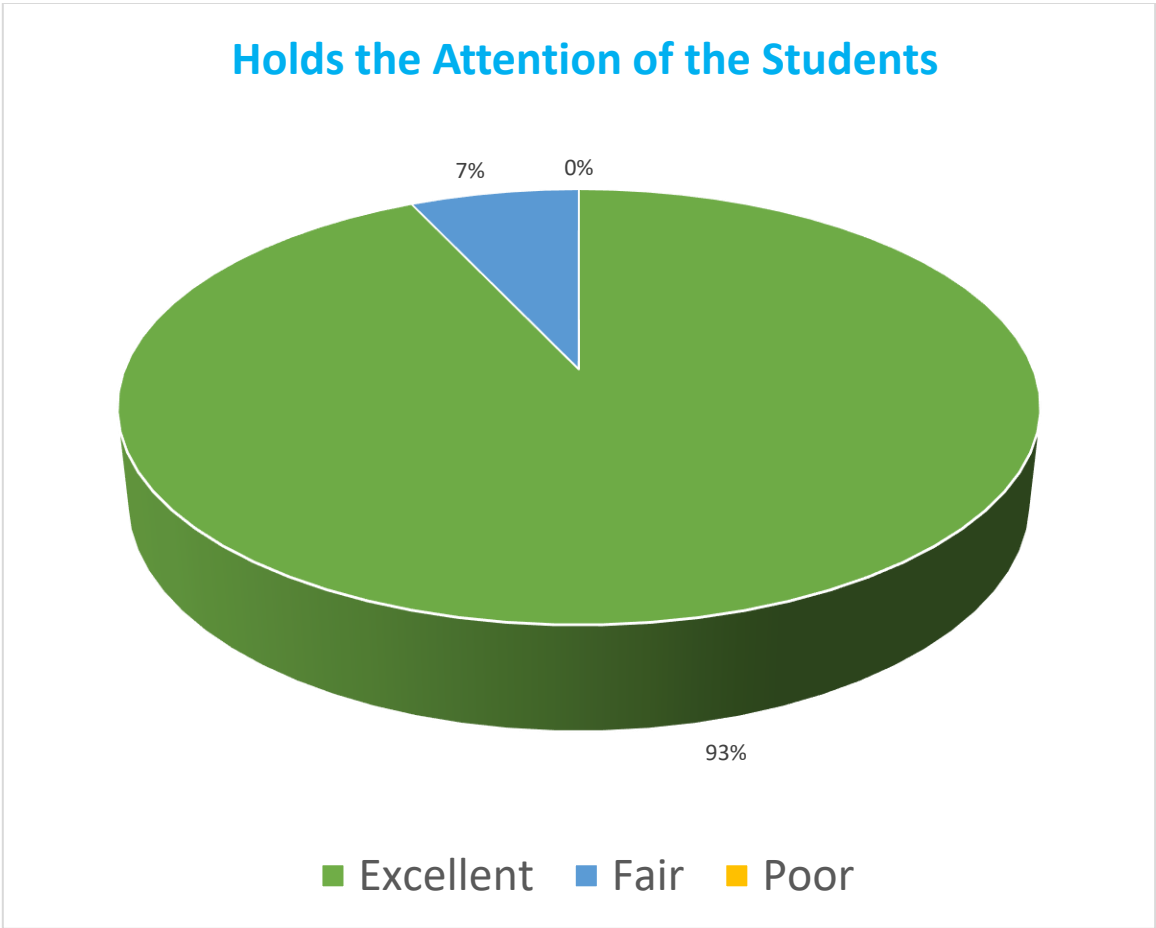

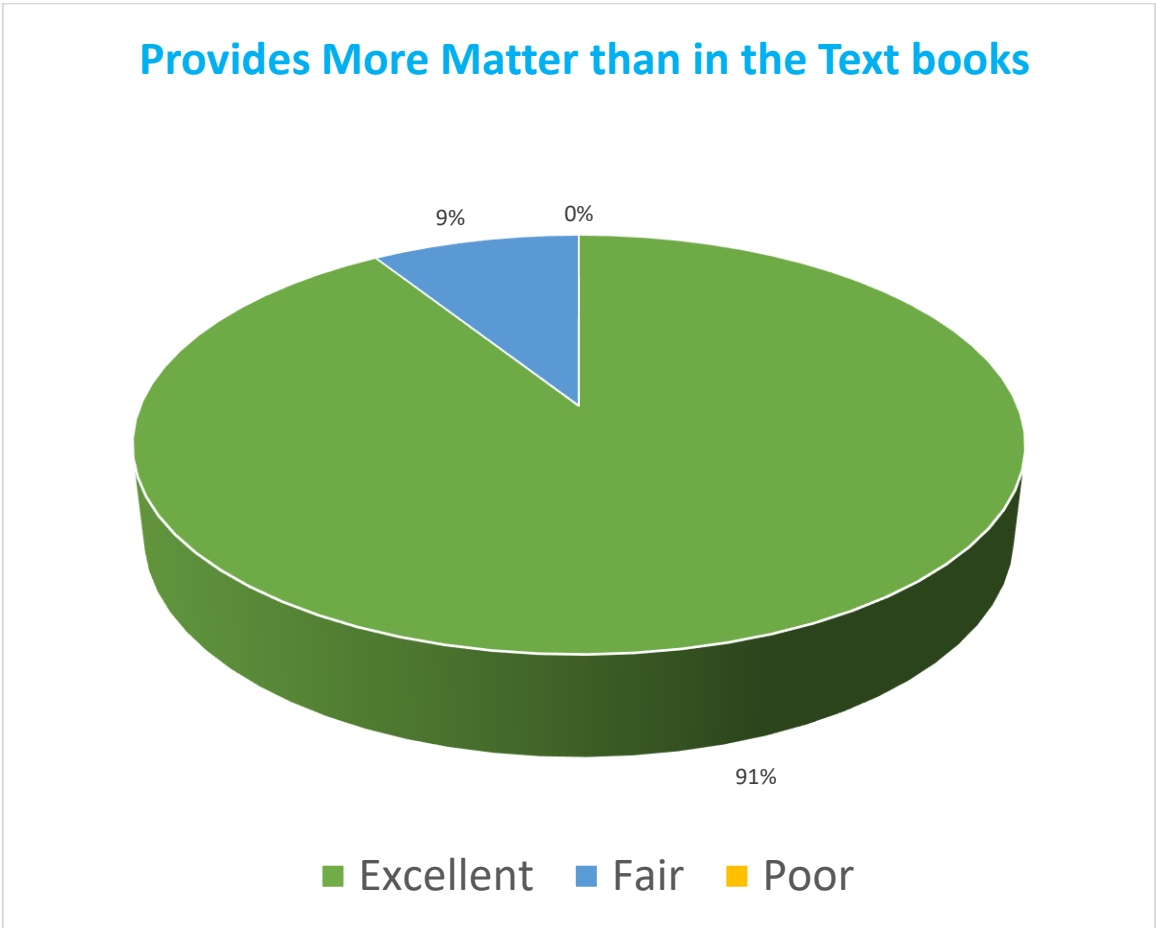

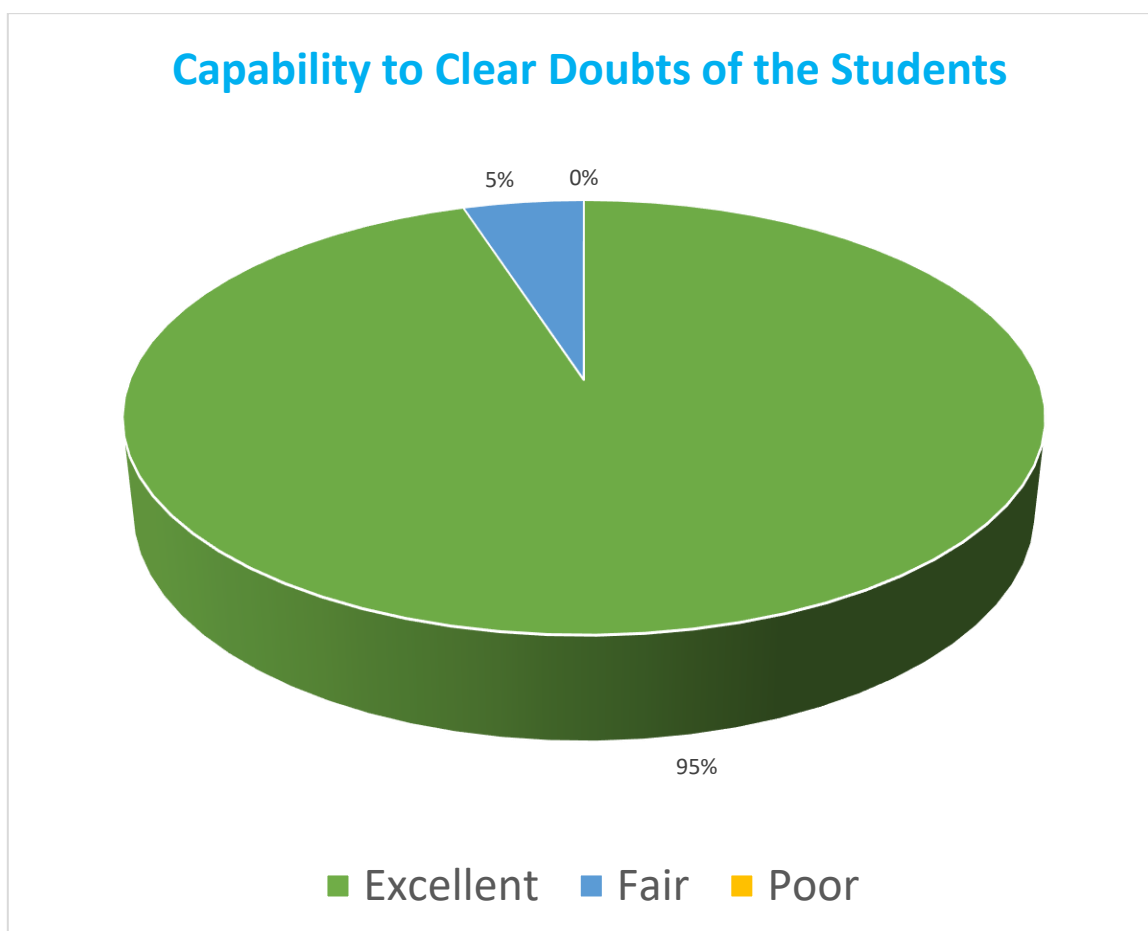

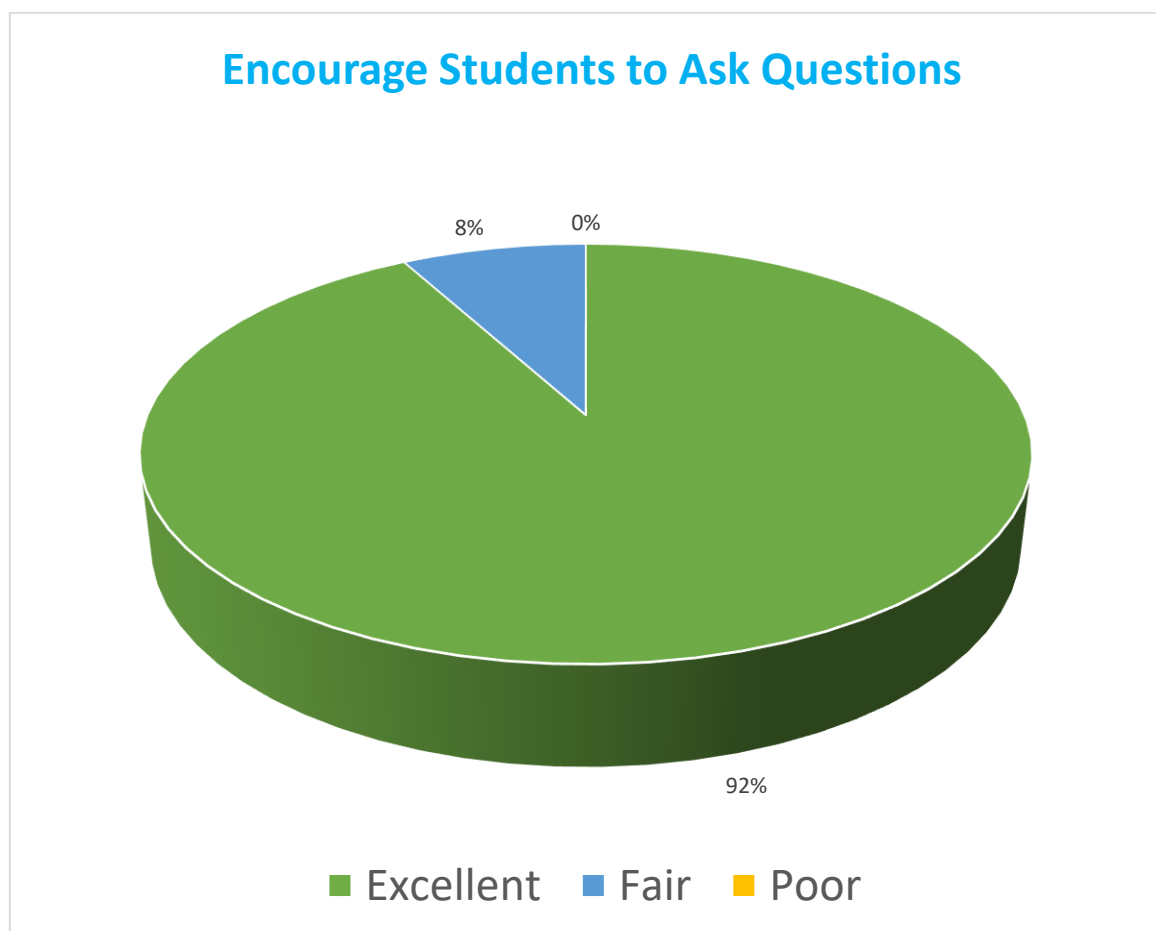

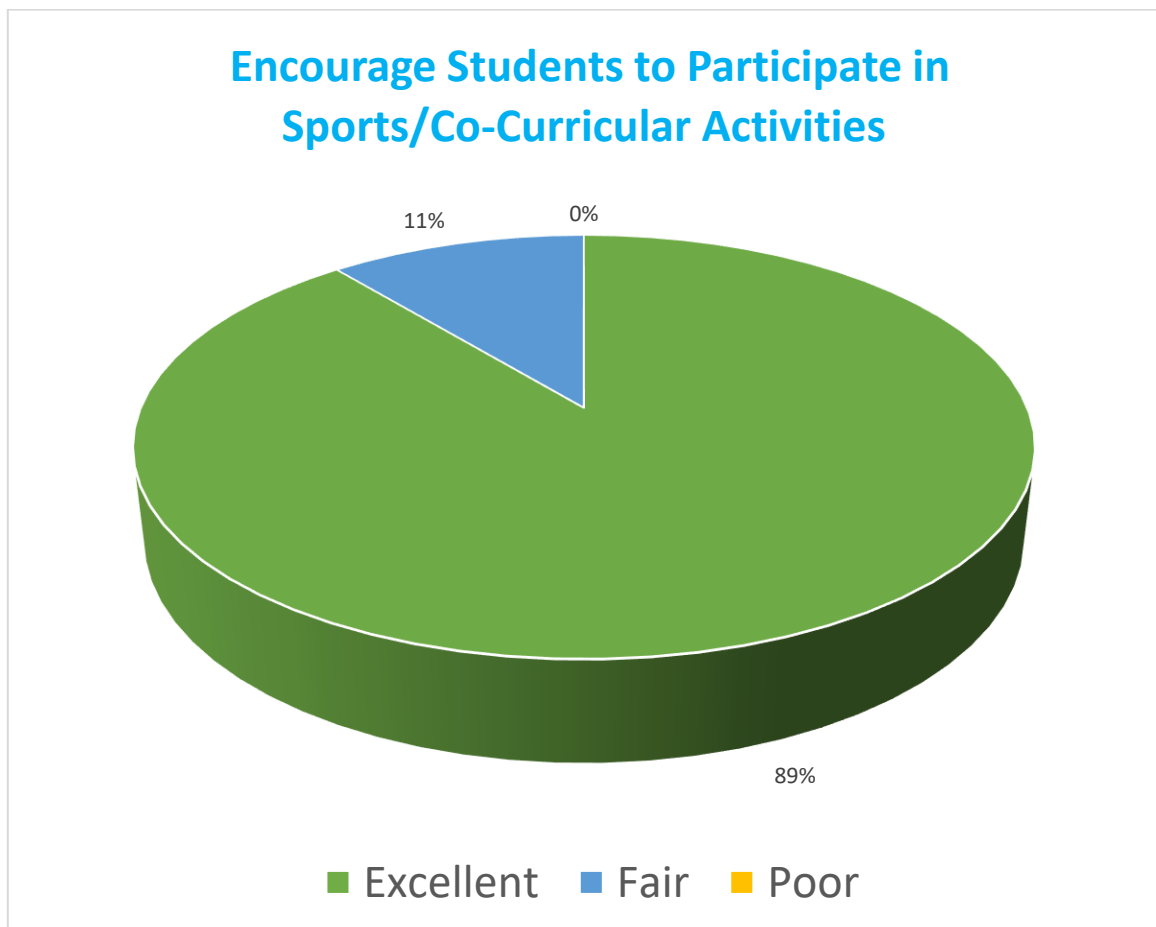

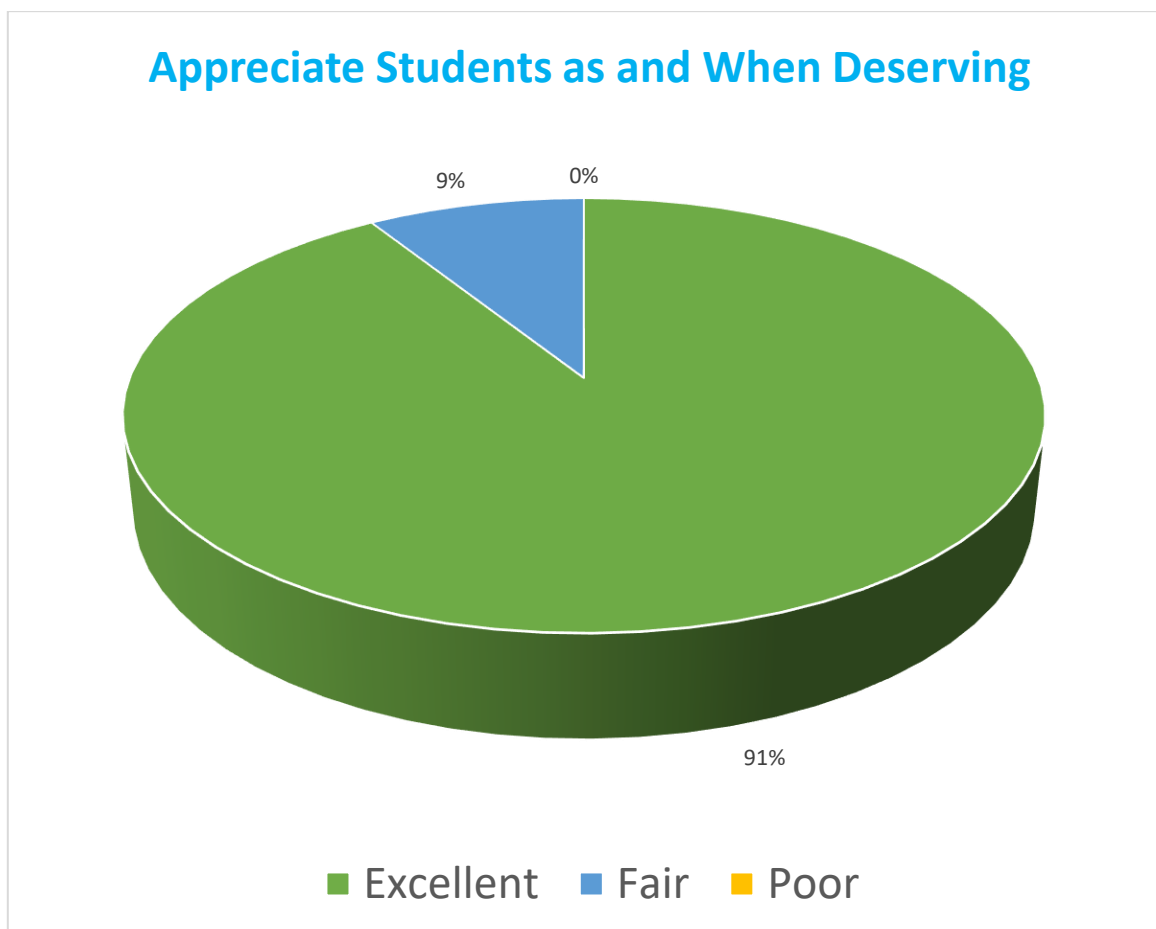

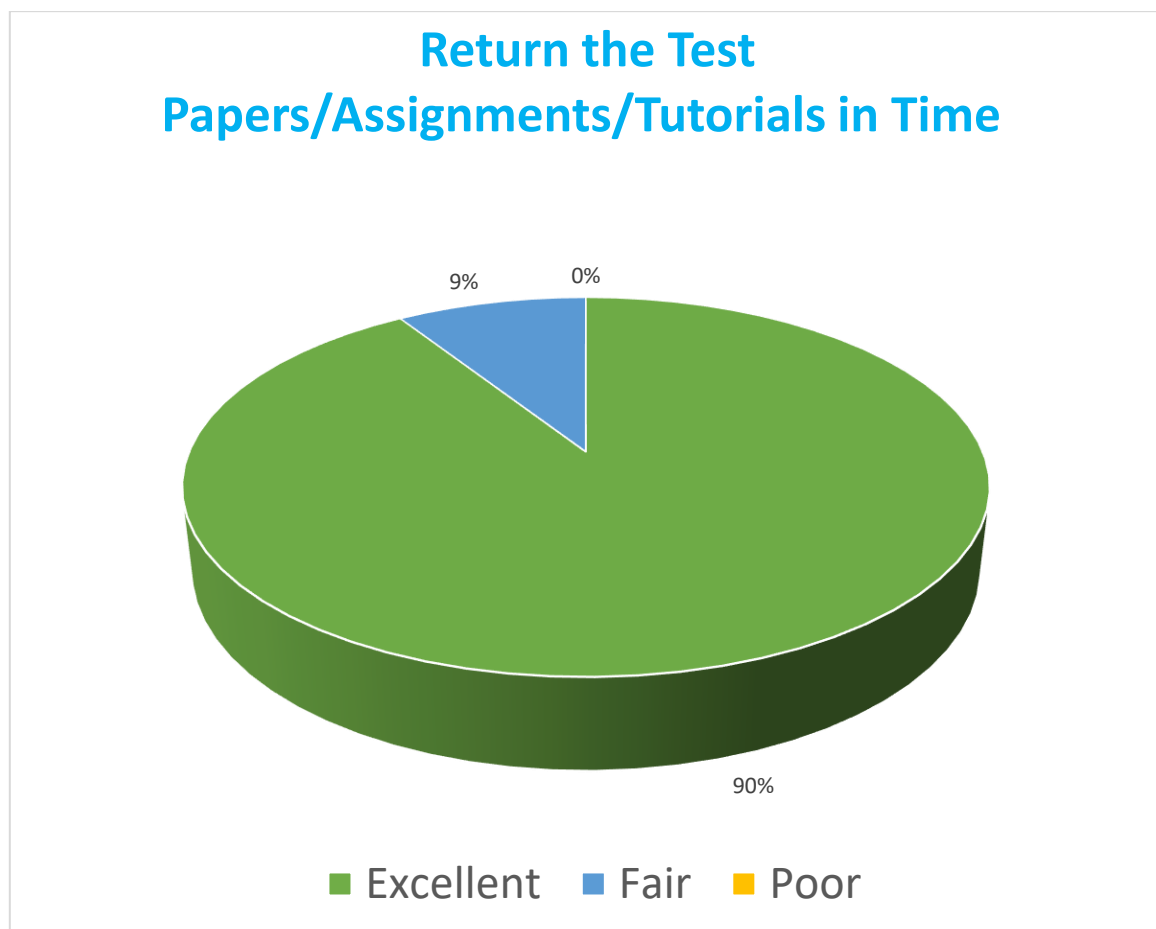

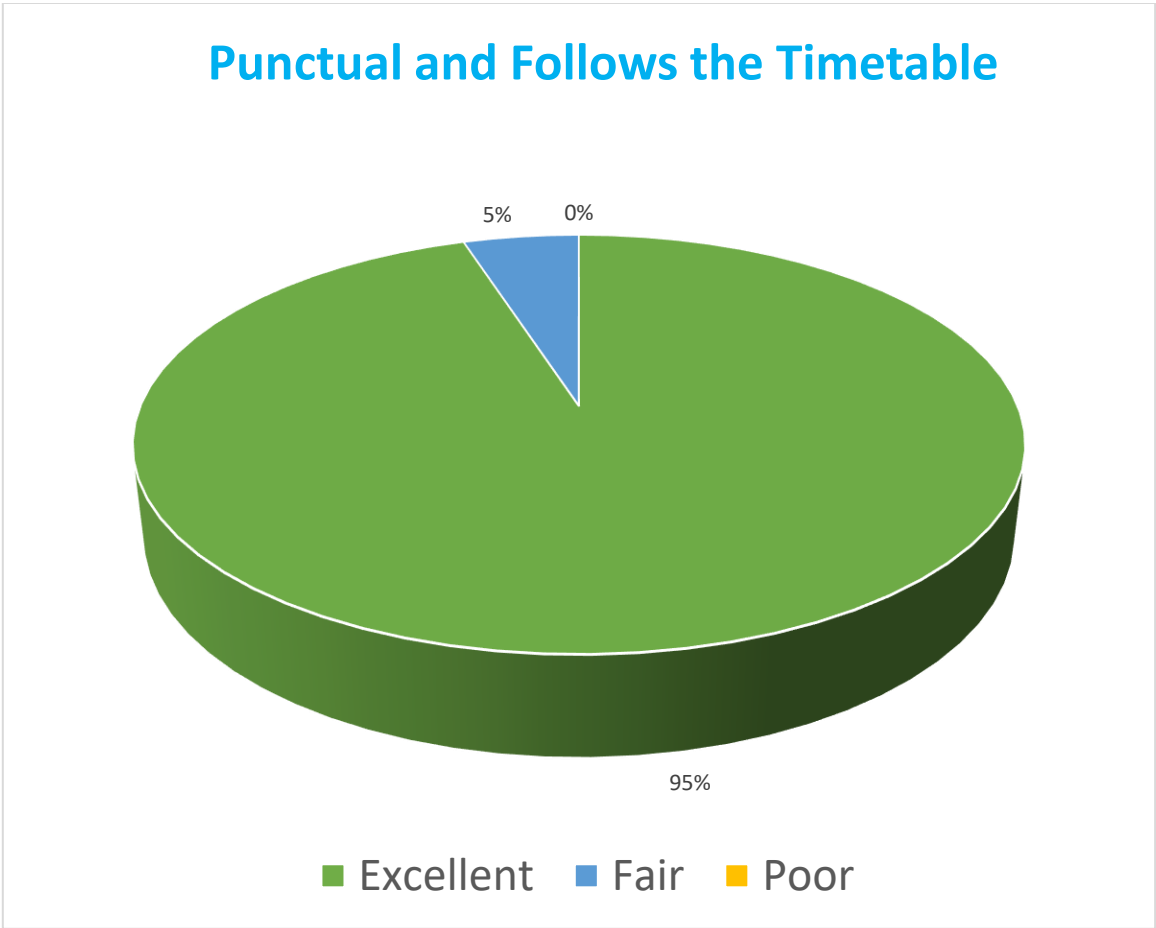

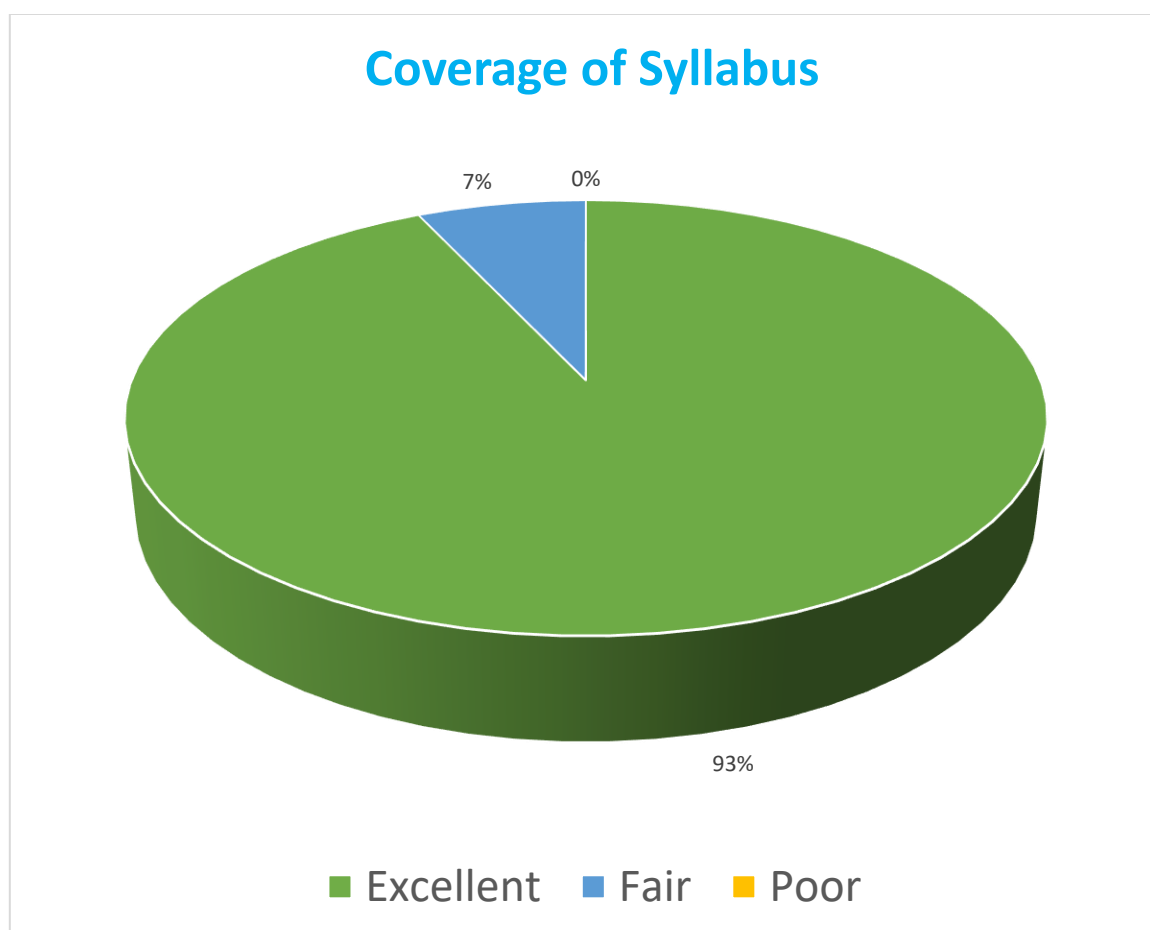
